The Academic Fair takes place in the spring and allows for students to display an experiment or research project based on any academic subject of their choice.

Cultural Enrichment Events

Dine-Out Nights

These are Latimer Lane's designated family nights at various local restaurants. These events are planned to give families the opportunity to dine out socially as a group while supporting local businesses. Take out is often an option too! The restaurant donates a portion of all sales generated back to the PTO.

Election Day Bake Sale11/3/2026

Every year on Election Day a committee of volunteers organizes a Bake Sale that district voters enjoy. Poll workers and voters consider this event a staple of their day! All proceeds support the Latimer Lane PTO.

Family B-I-N-G-L-O-W Night3/12/2027

A Latimer Lane School favorite! Families play BINGO while getting to see all of their friends, eat snacks, and win prizes! Mr. Luzietti MC's this event and offers the grand prize of lunch with the principal for the winner and a friend. Last year's BINGLOW was a crowd favorite!



Family Halloween Event10/30/2026 (FREE to Latimer Families)

Latimer Lane PTO annually hosts a Halloween themed event for families. We plan to have a costume parade, snacks and treats, and an outdoor movie! Stay tuned for updates.

This is Latimer Lane's designated Family Skate Event at the Simsbury Farms Ice Rink. Enjoy Skating, Hot Cocoa, and a fun time with family and friends.

Latimer Lane's annual Readathon has become the biggest fundraiser for the PTO. Last year we raised over \$13,000. The kids look forward to reading and participating in pajama reading days and winning various prizes.

Run Back to School 5K/1K & Fun Run10/4/2026

Celebrate the start of the school year by joining the community for a fun event to promote healthy and active students and families. Run or walk the 5K, 1 Mile Run, or Fun Run. This event is for all ages & abilities. Proceeds will benefit the Latimer Lane School Physical Education Program.

Scholastic Book Fair

The Scholastic Book Fair takes place during days of Parent -Teacher Conferences. Not only is the Scholastic Book Fair a great opportunity to provide your child with new reading materials at affordable prices, but it also supports classroom libraries and the Latimer Lane Library Media Center.

Staff Appreciation Week5/3/2026 to 5/7/2027

Held around nationally recognized Teacher Appreciation Day, the committee treats the Latimer Lane School Faculty with goodies to show them how much the community appreciates all they do for the students at Latimer Lane School.

Walk / Bike to School Day5/7/2027

An annual event sponsored by the Safe Routes to School Committee that takes place in the spring time. Families participate by walking or biking to school from home or from designated meeting spots in groups chaperoned by volunteers. Latimer Lane School's Safe Routes Committee pioneered this event in our town, and creates an opportunity for students who normally cannot walk / bike to school to experience a "green" and active commute. The event is recognized by local media coverage and over half the student body participates.

OUR PTO COMMITTEES

Academic Fair Committee

This committee plans and executes the annual Academic Fair, including set up, break down, and award distribution.

Beautification Committee

This committee provides extra touches around the outside of the school on a seasonal basis.

Cultural Enrichment Committee

This committee works with the other elementary schools to provide cultural enrichment programming. It is made up of at least 2 volunteers from each of the 5 elementary schools plus a president. It typically meets once a month to review and choose performances and is a great way to meet parents from the other schools!

Election Day Bake Sale Committee

This committee will collect and sell baked goods and other treats to voters and poll workers at our school on election day.



Family Fun Events - BINGLOW Committee

This committee plans and executes the BINGLOW night event.

Family Fun Events - Halloween Committee

This committee plans and executes the Halloween event.

Family Fun Events - Ice Skating Committee

This committee plans and orchestrates the Ice Skating Event.

Run Back to School 5K & Fun Run Committee

This committee plans, coordinates, and executes the annual Back To School runs to raise funds for our playground and athletic program.

Safe Routes to School Committee

This committee works towards advocating the mission of Safe Routes to School and plans the Walk / Bike to School Day.

Scholastic Book Fair Committee

This committee plans, coordinates, and executes the two book fairs held in the Fall & Spring.

Ski Club Committee

This committee is a group of parents who plan and chaperone the seasonal Ski Club at Latimer Lane School. The club travels to Ski Sundown in New Hartford, CT throughout the winter.

Staff Appreciation Committee

This committee works collaboratively to plan events for Staff Appreciation Day, as well as Staff Appreciation Week.

Welcoming Committee

This committee helps set up events for families new to the school. Some of these events include summer playground playdates and an ice cream social for incoming kindergarteners and new families.

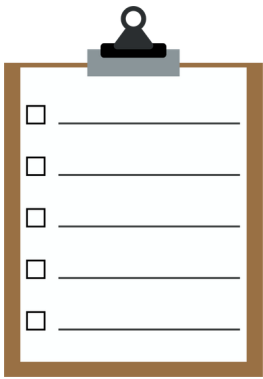

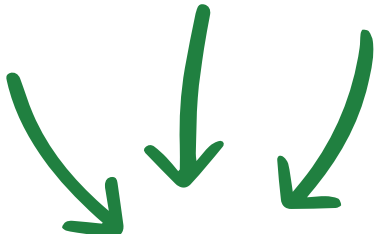
